Gordon Kaiser acts as counsel in competition law and regulatory matters. He also acts as an arbitrator in energy, infrastructure and commercial contract disputes. He served as Vice Chairman of the Ontario Energy Board for six years and has advised the Alberta Utilities Commission on settlements with the Market Surveillance Administrator.

He was a visiting Professor in the University of Toronto Law and Economics Program for one year and served as an Adjunct Professor at Queens University and the University of Toronto where he taught competition law, intellectual property and economic regulation.

Mr. Kaiser has appeared in the Courts of Ontario, New Brunswick, Nova Scotia, and Newfoundland as well as the Federal Court of Canada and the Supreme Court of Canada. He has appeared in regulatory proceedings in six provinces as well as a number of Federal Tribunals.

Mr. Kaiser acted for the Commissioner of Competition in both the Petroleum Industry Inquiry and the Telecommunications Equipment Inquiry before the Restrictive Trade Practice Commission. He also acted for the Commissioner of Competition before the CRTC as well as before Nova Scotia, New Brunswick and Prince Edward Island regulators. He also acted for the Canadian Radio Common Carriers Association before the CRTC and the Alberta Public Utilities Commission.

Mr. Kaiser has acted for the Attorney General of Canada in criminal prosecutions under the Competition Act. He also acted as defence counsel civil and criminal proceedings involving bid rigging, price maintenance, price discrimination, misleading advertising, and mergers.

In energy matters Mr. Kaiser acted as counsel to the Association of Municipalities of Ontario in proceedings before the Ontario Energy Board and the National Energy Board. He also acted as Counsel to the Ontario Energy Board for five years.

Mr. Kaiser's arbitration practice has involved multi-million dollar disputes with respect to the long term supply of electricity, oil, and gas. He is a member of the London Court of International Arbitration, the ADR Institute of Canada, the ICC Canadian Arbitration Committee, the Association of International Petroleum Negotiators and a Fellow of the Chartered Institute of Arbitrators, London England.

Mr. Kaiser has served on the boards of the California Alliance for Advanced Transportation Systems, and the Ontario Telephone Service Commission. He is the author of three books, Competition Law in Canada; Energy Law and Policy; and Corporate Crime in Canada. Mr. Kaiser is a graduate of the University of Toronto (BA) and Queens University (MA, JD).

Mr. Kaiser is a member of the Advocates Society, the Canadian Bar Association, the American Bar Association, the International Bar Association and the Energy Bar Association. In 2011 he was named Energy Lawyer of the Year by the Energy Law Forum.

Mr. Kaiser has served on a number of corporate boards including Skytel Communications, a subsidiary of Bell Canada. He is presently on the board of AltaLink Ontario, a subsidiary of Alberta's largest electricity transmitter, the St. Elizabeth Foundation, a nationwide non-profit health service provider and the Cleantech Practice Group of the MaRS Discovery District.
